- E) Federation of Education in India, 203, 2-A/3, Kundan Mansion, Asaf Ali Road, Near Connaught Place, New Delhi 110002, Second party is in "FOEII FOUNDATION" (Federation of Education in India) is a legal entity (Section 8 company-Not for Profit) registered (UIN "U85300DL2023NPL410237") on January 20th 2023, with Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) Government of India with office of the company situated in heart of "DELHI". The entity is to work for its objectives and governed by a "Governing Council" (a collaborative and collective combination of Academia, Industry, Skill India, Entrepreneurs, and Team FOEII with PARTNERS) to work for MISSION & VISION of 'FOEII'.)

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep



each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 **Industrial Training & Visits:** Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. - 2.3 **Internships and Placement of Students:** Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs, as per AICTE internship Policy. The Second Party will also register itself on AICTE Internship Policy Portal for disseminating the Internship opportunities available with them. Hiring students for internship & Live project for practical training.
- 2.4 **Campus interview:** The second party will come for campus requirement where intake depends up on the clearance of all the rounds by the candidate in the selection process.
- 2.5 **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.6 **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the continuing development for every intern through our exceptional training solutions in BFSI sector.



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- 2.7 **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.8 **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting industrial exposure/ training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 2.9 **Management Development Programs:** First Party to train the member of Second Party to through Management Development programs abreast with the latest skills.
- 2.10 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of –Interns with specialization in Marketing and HR, passionate to make their career in Banking and Financial Sector.
- 2.11 **Projects and Consultancy:** Both the parties agree to coordinate with each other on various projects and consultancy on various sectors of management.
- 2.12 **Branding & Strengthen of Relations:** Both the parties agree to use logo of each other for branding and strengthen of relations and can publicize on website and other social media.
- 2.13 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 2.14 There is no financial commitment on the part of the **Institute of Management Education**, the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period (**Federation of Education in India**), the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of (**Federation of Education in India**), the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU

- 4.1 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations



CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party, **M/s Institute of Management Education** and Second Party, **(Federation of Education in India)**, are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

CLAUSE 6: ARBITRATION

6.1 Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Delhi only.

Institute of Management of Education, Ghaziabad which expression shall, wherever the context so permits mean and include successors and assigns.)


WHEREAS

Now this MoU witnesses as under:

1. Scope of the MoU

1.1 hereby agrees to become the Institutional Member of ICT ACADEMY

1.2 ICT ACADEMY and Institute of Management of Education, Ghaziabad would collaborate to offer services to the faculty members of the college in the areas of Information and Communication Technology.

2 Role of ICT ACADEMY

2.6 ICT Academy shall also support the institution in getting the membership and resources from various corporate partners to the university.

2.6.1 ICT Academy will organize 1 Power Seminar, inviting the corporate professionals, through virtual or Physical mode. The topics and focus areas may be discussed and decided on mutual consent.

3.4 Institute of Management of Education, Ghaziabad shall provide necessary food facilities to the participating faculty members at a nominal fee. 

Career Counselling Service, 15/300, DDA Flats, Madangir, Delhi, PIN – 110062, hereafter known as CCS.


Preamble

1. THE FIRST PARTY

2. THE SECOND PARTY:

It primarily discharges its responsibilities for online and offline training of Entrepreneurship development on behalf of Ministry of MSME , as incubator in the field of Entrepreneurship development . The training is through online portal and mobile apps.(Hereinafter called the 'Second Party or IID, which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the subject or context thereof, include its successors and assignors)

It is also a START UP Incubator promoted by Govt of Uttar Pradesh and set up under PPP mode to educate, update and train Professionals and entrepreneurs and guide them with the latest technology, schemes, manufacturing processes, Machinery details, project cost etc



3. Purpose of MOU:

Self-employment and entrepreneurship development is a key concern for both the parties and both are working for it according to their strength and domain expertise. It is obvious that UNIVERSITY is more focused on their key area of education and IID is focused on Entrepreneurship development, skill development and providing industrial knowledge to create industry ready educated youth. Therefore, this MOU is designed to synergise the common area of expertise and focus on entrepreneurship development and skill development of educated youth, who are enrolled in various courses of various streams of education.

- 3.1. The youth should be motivated through online workshops and EDP training, Industrial Readiness Program (IRP) through online portal and mobile apps. The students should be enrolled according to their domain specific stream related business models or industries. IID is imparting Training, providing guidance and updation of knowledge of aspiring students regarding setting up of industries, start-ups and small businesses through its unique incubation process.
- 3.2. IID is only virtual incubator in India with Ministry of MSME, which is nurturing the youth and aspiring Entrepreneurs through weekly live Industrial workshop, expert episodes, industrial documentaries, project reports, registration and Government schemes guidance. It is also managing MSME helpline through its call center. It has its own YouTube channel named "Entrepreneur India TV" and "Udyami India". It has its own production house at Rajghat, New Delhi which comprises of fully equipped Audio Video Studio with Chroma Facility, Editing Room, and Live Streaming equipment in Real Time. It has in house production team, which comprises of cinematographers, editors, anchors and content writers.
- 3.3. IID will get enrolled the students from various stream of university on IID portal iid.org.in and [entrepreneur India Live](#) apps for Online Entrepreneurship Development training and nurturing with various industrial process. The student may download the mobile apps to update themselves about the working of the various industries, which may give them better understanding of their job roles as well as help in self-employment. IID shall also provide this platform to Alumni students of various streams to do EDP programme, who want to start their business after doing jobs or have not been able to get employment according to their qualification and skills. These Entrepreneurs can generate employment through this process and the upcoming students may be employed under these industries.

Both organizations agree to undertake the following activities

4. First Party Roles:

The role of First Party shall include the work Designated to their



departments, faculties and allied institution of the First party. The role may be defined as follows:


- 4.1. The First party shall provide their platform to IID regarding Implementation of Entrepreneurship development Programme (EDP), skill development programme and allied nurturing programmes at their various stream of education on compulsory project on quarterly basis. These students are allotted projects according to their stream of education.
- 4.2. The First Party shall advise the concerned technical agencies involved in student system management for integration of data with our online portal and apps to conduct workshops and seminars according to their stream. This will enable students to upgrade their knowledge and information about industries. They can submit their project online after attending or watching various industrial documentaries and workshops. The assessment shall also be made online and certificate may be downloaded online.
- 4.3. The students, who wish to be self-employed or wish to start business or industry or start-ups, it shall be made mandatory for them to join online EDP courses for long term nurturing and guidance. These students are eligible to apply loan under PMEGP scheme after completion of education and exempted for mandatory EDP training for disbursement of loan by this certification of IID.
- 4.4. The expert and faculties of university shall update lectures or workshop at our mobile apps with university logo and it may be utilized by the IID to show in their website or you Tube channel to promote the content as well as university initiatives.
- 4.5. First Party shall appoint a nodal officer or team for coordinators from various streams to implement this programme in effective manner and Generate valuable contents for the students. They shall give the suggestions and programme scheduling with mutual consent with team IID.
- 4.6. First party shall Collaborate and coordinate with IID to establish pool of technologies, expertise, technology providers, technology seekers and other resource persons throughout the country in undertaking any related activities.
- 4.7. First Party will provide opportunity to each student for entrepreneurial evaluation, selection, development, management and most importantly, the nurturing in industrial domain. Both University and IID Incubator will mentor, assist and guide students and faculty in promoting and developing entrepreneurship and self-employment through continuous, professional and planned manner in every semester of each class as project on quarterly basis.
- 4.8 First Party will provide a space in their web portal for data integration with IID Portal through landing page which will be more interactive and informatics. During the data integration IID will follow the rule of Data Security.



5. Second Party Roles:

The IID shall conduct these roles / activities through their own and associate network. The IID is an incubator Ministry of MSME and shall provide virtual and physical nurturing of students through the use of technology and various online tools. The role of IID shall be as under:

- 5.1. The Second Party shall educate, train and guide students on various business models of entrepreneurs development and industrial nurturing of the students through online portal and mobile apps according to the domain of education.
- 5.2. The Second Party shall enroll students in mandatory entrepreneurship Development programme (EDP) or Industrial Solution Programme (ISP), irrespective of any stream of education. The project will be provided to the students on quarterly basis in each year under these programmes.
- 5.3. EDP/ISP training shall be available in video lecture format Hindi/English, recorded by renowned experts of industries and professionals. Along with these lectures PPT shall also be provided in English for better/ further understanding of the subject.
- 5.4. The EDP portal and mobile apps shall contain various industrial documentaries, experts episodes and project reports for various business models and related to education stream & job roles. These shall help Students to develop better understanding of the subject and help to start their business or getting a job
- 5.5. The online workshops and seminars are also telecast on mobile apps for the students on weekly basis for various industries and business models for the knowledge upgradation of all the enrolled students.
- 5.6. The empanelment of experts shall be done by the IID for various domain of expertise with the help of first party. These experts shall deliver their lectures and conduct live/ physical workshops from the studio of second party at Rajghat New Delhi or at University campus or other relevant places equipped with live streaming facilities of live telecast. Both the parties for their enrolled candidates may utilize these contents.
- 5.7. The Second party shall provide their portal and Mobile apps for this EDP/ISP implementation purpose and long term nurturing of the students. The local assistance shall be provided by the first party, regarding training aspect of apps operations and assessments.



5.8. The second party has established and nurtured various MSME's units under the PMEGP scheme till date, which are running successfully in pan India basis. These units may be advised to give opportunities to the students in applying in these Industries.

5.9. The Second party shall extend help to all students after completion of their studies, who want to start own business, industry, service sector unit or want to do self-employment work in applying loans under PMEGP scheme online for project cost up to 10 lacs for service sector and project up to 25 Lacs for manufacturing sector.

5.10. The second party shall guide the students through a call centre for students for different type of knowledge of EDP/ISP training, projects, business registration and Job opportunities.

5.11. The second party shall provide knowledge of major Government schemes through their portal in video and PPT formats at the portal and mobile apps.

5.12. The second party has EDP content of 100 hours in video/PPT format(Hindi & English) in the form of industrial documentaries, experts episodes, project reports and further other allied content on business models and industries should be developed according to requirements on regular basis.



6. The financial cost structure will be decided by the both parties on mutually agreed basis. The financial cost shall include the cost of onetime services like industrial documentaries, episodes, EDP course content and project report and other component of recurring operational costs to run portal, hosting, call centre etc. This will be made part of the MoU or exchange through letter or mail.
7. This MOU is valid for a duration of the five year from the date of signing this agreement and this MOU is extended or replaced by other agreement on similar or amended terms and conditions as agreed by the both the parties.
8. This agreement to arbitrate shall be specifically enforceable. A Party may apply to any court with jurisdiction for interim or conservatory relief, including without limitation a proceeding to compel arbitration.
9. In the event of breach of the MOU/agreement the UNIVERSITY and IID shall make reasonable efforts to reach an amicable settlement thereof. If they cannot reach an amicable settlement all disputes arising in connection with this MOU thereof the same shall be referred to a Arbitrator appointed on mutual consent of both the parties. The city of arbitration shall be New Delhi, India.
10. UNIVERSITY and IID are free to terminate the MoU at three month notice as per mutual consent; however this shall not affect the training of the students already enrolled.
11. Both parties agree that each other's logo shall be used in all promotions, documentaries, episodes, documents concerned by other party and related to training only, but not for any other commercial purpose.
12. Any amendment or changes in the scope of work or term of engagement under MoU could be modified from time to time with mutual consent and writing.
13. It is certified that parties will mutually discuss and consult each other for any provisions arising out of this agreement in order to identify and decide upon the manner in which the activities are to be done. Parties will be guided about their role and related activities from time to time by way of exchanging letter and emails.
14. If the no activities take place within a period of 3 months. The MOU ceases to be operative and can only be reviewed with mutual consent by exchange of letter or a mail.





MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MOU") is made and deemed to be executed on the day and date when the counter party(ies) sign or affix its/their signature(s) hereunder.

BETWEEN

Institute of Management Education, a college/Institute/University recognized under Section 2(f) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act 1956 and having address at: 178, Grand Trunk Rd, Block 10, Sector 3, Sahibabad, Ghaziabad, Ghaziabad (M Corp.), 201005, Uttar Pradesh, India

Through its Principal/Director/Vice Chancellor/Dean

(hereinafter referred to as "PARTNER INSTITUTE")

AND

BAJAJ FINSERV LIMITED, a company registered under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956, having its registered office at: Bajaj Auto Ltd Complex, Mumbai-Pune Road, Pune 411 035

AND

BAJAJ FINANCE LIMITED, a company registered under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956, having its registered office at: Akurdi, Pune 411 035

(Bajaj Finserv Limited and Bajaj Finance Limited hereinafter collectively referred to as "FINSERV" and shall be represented by its authorized representative Mr. Kurush Irani - President (Corporate Social Responsibility) Bajaj Finserv Limited)

The expressions "PARTNER INSTITUTE" and "FINSERV" shall, collectively be referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

WHEREAS:

- A. PARTNER INSTITUTE established in 1995 by IME Society is affiliated to Chaudhary Charan Singh University.
- B. Bajaj Finserv Limited is the holding company for financial services businesses of the Bajaj Group;
- C. Bajaj Finance Limited is a Non-Banking Finance Company registered with Reserve Bank of India.

D. FINSERV, as part of its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities, desires to create employment opportunities for educated youth in the Banking, Finance and Insurance Sector through a customized training Program/s encompassing product knowledge, communication and other soft skills, which is expected to benefit fresh



graduates, especially those belonging to economically weaker sections of the society;

- E. FINSERV, in partnership with some of the leading educational institutes, has designed and developed customized corporate certification program/s under it's IN-HOUSE skilling Program called as SKILLSERV
- F. The PARTNER INSTITUTE has expressed its willingness to partner with FINSERV to conduct SKILLSERV Program/s for its students and alumni, on terms and conditions set out herein below;
- G. FINSERV has accepted the offer of the PARTNER INSTITUTE and agreed to partner with the PARTNER INSTITUTE for conducting SKILLSERV Program/s, on terms and conditions set out below.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AND IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS UNDER:

1. Purpose/Objective of SKILLSERV:

The objective of SKILLSERV is to impart practical knowledge and essential skills to the students of the PARTNER INSTITUTE, especially those belonging to economically weaker sections of the society, with a view to create employment opportunities for them in the Banking, Finance and Insurance Companies.

2. Scope of SKILLSERV:

- i. FINSERV has appointed different training institutes as Official Training Partners for conducting SKILLSERV Program/s (hereinafter referred to as SKILLSERV Official Training Partner/s).
- ii. FINSERV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE, through one of the SKILLSERV Official Training Partners, shall conduct, for the eligible students and alumni of the PARTNER INSTITUTE, Certificate Program/s in Banking, Finance and Insurance sector, covering industry overview/product knowledge relevant for various roles in banks, NBFCs, life insurance and general insurance companies, communication and other workplace skills. SKILLSERV Program/s shall be conducted through classroom training (hereinafter referred to as SKILLSERV -CLASSROOM), online training (hereinafter referred to as SKILLSERV -ONLINE) or a combination of classroom and online training (hereinafter referred to as SKILLSERV -BLENDED).

3. Responsibilities of the Parties:

- i. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be responsible for mobilizing students for the SKILLSERV Program/s by spreading awareness about SKILLSERV Program/s and its potential benefits for the prospective students. FINSERV shall, if requested by PARTNER INSTITUTE, at its discretion, support the awareness campaigns by participating in the student meetings, parent meetings and design of publicity material such as posters, leaflets etc.
- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be responsible for providing necessary infrastructure facilities for conducting classroom sessions of SKILLSERV -CLASSROOM and SKILLSERV -BLENDED, specifically (a) one class room, equipped with a projector, a sound system and a white-board with a seating capacity of at least 45 students, (b) one computer room, equipped with computers having MS Office software and high-speed internet connection, with a seating capacity of at least 25 students, for conducting the online assessment tests (c) one assembly hall with a capacity of around 60 persons and 3 interview rooms, for one day per batch, for conducting

SKILLSERV HR Workshop if required. PARTNER INSTITUTE shall also provide basic stationery required for training purposes such as marker pens, chart sheets, chalks etc.

- iii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall appoint a Coordinator for every SKILLSERV batch, with following responsibilities;
 - i. To motivate and encourage students to extract maximum benefit from SKILLSERV Program/s.
 - ii. To provide necessary support to the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner for planning and conducting the program.
 - iii. To conduct online pre-assessment and post-assessment tests for every batch when required in the Program.
 - iv. To ensure that the classes are conducted as per pre-defined schedule.
 - v. To ensure that all students are regularly attending the classes.
 - vi. To maintain daily attendance of the students.
 - vii. To attend few classes as an observer and provide feedback to FINSERV about the training quality.
 - viii. To ensure discipline and good conduct from the students.
 - ix. To support FINSERV team to conduct SKILLSERV HR Workshop for every batch when required for the Program.
 - x. To submit required college information as per Annexure 2 to FINSERV.
- iv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall issue an appointment letter to the College Coordinator as per format prescribed in Annexure 3 of this MOU. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall submit the appointment letter, duly authorized by the Principal of the PARTNER INSTITUTE and accepted by the College Coordinator, to FINSERV before commencement of every SKILLSERV Batch.
- v. FINSERV shall be responsible to design and continuously improve the SKILLSERV programme structure, including adding or deleting courses, changing pedagogy or modifications to the programme duration.
- vi. FINSERV shall be responsible to arrange faculty, with requisite expertise and experience, through any of its SKILLSERV Official Training Partners. FINSERV shall provide necessary details of the concerned SKILLSERV Official Training Partner to the PARTNER INSTITUTE at least 2 weeks before start of every batch. FINSERV shall be responsible to arrange the online training platform for conducting SKILLSERV - ONLINE and SKILLSERV - BLENDED.
- vii. FINSERV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE, shall be responsible for award of "Certificate of Completion" at the completion of SKILLSERV Program/s to all successful candidates who meet eligibility criteria viz. requisite attendance and credits in the examinations conducted during SKILLSERV Program/s.
- viii. FINSERV, as part of its CSR, shall bear the full cost of faculty deployed by its SKILLSERV Official Training Partner, to ensure that SKILLSERV Program/s is affordable to students belonging to economically weaker sections of the society.
- ix. FINSERV along with its chosen academic partner/s, shall conduct an online examination at the end of SKILLSERV Program/s. Only students who pass this examination and have requisite attendance shall be eligible to receive the "Certificate of Completion". This examination shall be in addition to all other examinations conducted by the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner during SKILLSERV Program/s.
- x. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall display the FINSERV name and logo prominently in all marketing and publicity material, notices for students and all other internal and

external communications, in paper form or otherwise, relating to SKILLSERV Program/s.

- xi. Any other use of FINSERV brand names by the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall require prior written consent from FINSERV.
- xii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall provide to FINSERV, necessary information about all the students of SKILLSERV Program/s, in the format specified by FINSERV in Annexure 1. FINSERV shall be free to contact the students directly for the purpose of monitoring the impact of SKILLSERV Program/s and the career progression of students.
- xiii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not conduct any of the SKILLSERV Program/s or a programme with identical course structure except in partnership with FINSERV.
- xiv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be solely responsible to comply with regulations of University Grants Commission or any other authority regulating educational activities in India. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that FINSERV shall not have any liability including monetary or otherwise, in the event of any regulatory action taken against the PARTNER INSTITUTE in respect of conducting this programme. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees to fully compensate FINSERV in case an action is taken against FINSERV by any such regulatory authority in respect of conduct of SKILLSERV Program/s by the PARTNER INSTITUTE under this MOU.
- xv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be solely responsible for payment of GST or any other taxes that may be applicable, in respect of fees collected by the PARTNER INSTITUTE for SKILLSERV Program/s and FINSERV shall not have any liability towards the same. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that FINSERV shall not have any liability, monetary or otherwise, in the event of any action is taken against the PARTNER INSTITUTE by any tax authorities. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees to fully compensate FINSERV in case any action is taken against FINSERV by any such tax authority in respect of conduct of SKILLSERV Program/s by the PARTNER INSTITUTE under this MOU.

4. Batch Strength:

The parties agree that, each batch shall consist of minimum 45 and maximum 60 students. FINSERV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE may mutually decide to start a batch with less than 45 students.

5. Term of the MOU:

The term of this MOU is for a period commencing from signing of this MoU till end of March 31, 2027, except Clause 3(xiii) and Clause 14, which shall continue to be in force for a further period of 3 years from the date of termination of this MOU. The parties may decide to further extend the term of this MOU by mutual consent on such terms and conditions as may be agreed between them.

6. Course fees:

- i. PARTNER INSTITUTE shall charge a non-refundable fee of Rs. 1000 (Rupees One Thousand only) plus applicable GST and other taxes, to each of the students of SKILLSERV towards the course fees. The fee payable by each student shall not be less than Rs. 1,000 (Rupees one thousand only) plus applicable taxes and shall not exceed Rs. 3,000 (Rupees three thousand) plus applicable taxes. The fees specified here shall be valid for two years from signing of this MOU. The fees shall be reviewed on completion of this period and parties may mutually agree to revise the same from time to time.

- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE has agreed to suitably remunerate the coordinator and other staff members for their effort towards successful conduct of SKILLSERV Program/s Batch.
- iii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE, may at its own discretion, waive the fees of upto 15% of the students from economically weaker sections, the number of such students must not exceed 15% of total enrolment in the respective batch.
- iv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall ensure that no student shall be allowed to attend SKILLSERV Program/s without paying the full fees except those permitted under sub-clause iv above.
- v. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall submit to FINSERV, before commencement of any batch, extracts of bank statement or copies of cash receipts or a letter from the Principal or Vice-Principal confirming collection of fees from every participant.

7. Duration and contents of SKILLSERV:

- i. Partner Institute shall commence the SKILLSERV Program/s within 90 days of signing of this MoU. The said Programme will involve training as per the Program/s details as provided under respective Program Annexures, which shall deem to be attached hereto to form part of this MOU.
- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE has agreed to mobilize, on best effort basis, at least 40 students in first academic year and at least 80 students from second academic year onwards. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall decide the batch schedule and timings and inform the schedule to FINSERV at least 10 days before commencement of the batch.
- iii. FINSERV shall arrange to make the faculty available as per the schedule informed by the PARTNER INSTITUTE.
- iv. Detailed schedule of the lectures and practical shall be given in advance to students before commencement of SKILLSERV Program/s.

8. Place of teaching:

The SKILLSERV classroom teaching and practical shall be conducted at Institute of Management Education, Ghaziabad (M Corp.) by the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner, for up to four hours a day on such days, dates and at such timings as may be mutually decided between the parties.

9. Eligibility for SKILLSERV:

- i. Any student who is a student/alumni of the College and fits in the eligibility criteria (academic + Age Limit) for the Program shall be eligible to apply for admission to SKILLSERV Program/s.
- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall select the final list of candidates for admission based on the criteria mutually agreed upon by the PARTNER INSTITUTE and FINSERV from time to time.

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10. Discipline and right to expel:

- i. The students of SKILLSERV -CLASSROOM and SKILLSERV -BLENDED shall be subject to rules of discipline/code of conduct of the PARTNER INSTITUTE during course



period. In case of SKILLSERV – ONLINE, the students shall be subject to rules of discipline/code of conduct of the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner.

- ii. If the concerned SKILLSERV Official Training Partner observes a breach of code of conduct by any student, it shall immediately report the same to the College SKILLSERV Coordinator for necessary action.
- iii. If any participant commits breach of code of conduct of the PARTNER INSTITUTE, the faculty shall have full authority to expel such student for the remaining duration of SKILLSERV Program/s.

11. Faculty:

- i. FINSERV shall be solely responsible for arranging, through a SKILLSERV Official Training Partner, faculty, with requisite industry and teaching experience, and conducting SKILLSERV efficiently and effectively. The PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not be responsible for making any payments to the faculty of the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner.
- ii. Some of the lectures of SKILLSERV may be conducted by the experts from FINSERV as per the understanding between the parties. However, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not be liable to pay any amounts to FINSERV towards the said lectures.

12. Certification:

FINSERV and the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall issue a "Certificate of Completion" in SKILLSERV Program/s to the eligible students of SKILLSERV-CLASSROOM, SKILLSERV -ONLINE and SKILLSERV -BLENDED. The certificates shall be designed and printed by FINSERV and shall carry the names of the PARTNER INSTITUTE and the concerned SKILLSERV Official Training Partner.

13. Further Agreements:

The parties agree that, they may mutually discuss and enter into further agreements, if needed.

14. Confidentiality:

- i. The Parties agree to maintain strict secrecy and confidentiality regarding any and all Confidential Information exchanged or to be exchanged between them in relation to this MOU.
- ii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that all the course material provided by FINSERV or the SKILLSERV Official Training Partner, including but not limited to SKILLSERV structure, curriculum, lesson plans and evaluation methods, shall be deemed to be Confidential Information.
- iii. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees that any of FINSERV's technical or business or other information including information given for development of any case studies / development of any program modules / contents, made available by FINSERV or its personnel to the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall be deemed to be Confidential Information.

- iv. The PARTNER INSTITUTE agrees to restrict access and disclosure of Confidential Information to such of their employees, agents, vendors, and contractors strictly on a "need to know" basis, to maintain confidentiality of the Information disclosed to it in accordance with this clause.



- v. Information and material disclosed and provided by each party to the other party in pursuance of or in connection with performance of its obligation under this MOU shall, at all times, remain the sole and exclusive property of the disclosing Party.

15. Intimation about cancellation/postponement of SKILLSERV Program/s:

- i. If due to any cogent reasons, it appears to the PARTNER INSTITUTE that it is unable to arrange any batch as per schedule, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall intimate about its inability to FINSERV at least 30 days in advance and the parties shall decide further schedule of SKILLSERV Program/s by mutual consent. FINSERV may decide to complete such batches through online classes.
- ii. However, if such postponement or cancellation is necessitated due to any last minute, unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances like Act of God, civil commotion, strike, bandh, disruption of traffic, epidemic, war, aggression, change in Government Policy or any other similar circumstances, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall intimate the change in schedule as early as possible after such circumstances as stated above have arisen. In such circumstances, the PARTNER INSTITUTE shall not be held liable for payment towards any loss or damages caused to FINSERV due to delay in its schedule.
- iii. If for any reason, FINSERV, decides to discontinue support for SKILLSERV Program/s, it shall give a written notice to the PARTNER INSTITUTE, 30 days in advance. Such notice shall not impact any batch which is already in progress on the date of notice and the terms of this MOU shall continue to apply to the running batches.

16. Amendment/Termination:

- i. Any amendment to the terms of this MOU can only be made by mutual consent of the parties.
- ii. This MOU may be terminated by either party, for breach of terms and conditions of the present MOU or otherwise, by a written notice of at least one (1) month in advance. Such notice of termination shall not interfere with the batches underway at the relevant time. Such batches shall be allowed to continue until their conclusion.
- iii. Both the parties agree that Finserv shall have the right of terminating this MOU without any notice to the PARTNER INSTITUTE, if the PARTNER INSTITUTE charges a fee exceeding the amount prescribed under Clause 6(i) of this MOU. In such event, the batches underway at the relevant time, may also be terminated by FINSERV, unless the PARTNER INSTITUTE refunds the excess fee charged to every student of the batch.

17. Applicable Law and Dispute Settlement:

- i. This MOU shall be governed by the Laws of India.
- ii. Any dispute arising between the parties in connection with or arising out of the performance of mutual obligations under this MOU shall be resolved by mutual discussion and consultation. If the dispute remained unresolved even after 30 days, then the dispute shall be referred to the Principal/Director/Vice Chancellor/Dean of Institute of Management Education and Mr. Kurush Irani, President – Corporate Social Responsibility, Bajaj Finserv Limited. The decision of the principal of Institute of Management Education and Mr. Kurush Irani shall be final and binding on both parties.
